The Idaho Federation needs help. As a business management team, the Federation assures that all clubs and active dancers in the

state receive the proper insurance they need to cover the dance venues, club officers and individuals. Through United Square Dancers of America (USDA.org), insurance for all individuals, clubs and the federation is obtained at a very low rate.

Our Federation position of Insurance Chairman needs to be filled by January 2019. This chairman assembles information provided by the Clubs and Area Representatives, checks for proper payment, and submits forms and payment to USDA. It requires a thorough review of all individual dancers and where they frequently dance. The Insurance Chairman also issues the proper proof-of-insurance forms for venues where clubs and groups regularly dance as well as where special public dances are held.

The majority of work is in November and December when membership information is prepared for submission by the start of the new year.

Please consider contributing your time to this important position. We all enjoy our activity and square & round dancers have a reputation of offering their help when needed. The insurance chairman can reside in any area of the state as nearly all correspondence is by email or the postal service.

Don Swartz has done an impeccable job as Insurance Chairman for several years. He wishes to resign this position, but is more than willing to offer assistance to the new chairman as well as detailed information to anyone interested in what the position entails.
