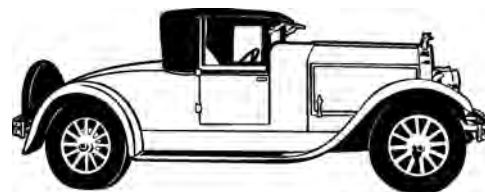
Directions to
 Boise Valley Square & Round Dance Hall

Once on I-84: Take Exit 52, Orchard St. Head south to take the ramp toward Gowen Field. Head south onto S. Orchard St for 0.2 miles. Turn right onto W. Victory Rd. for 0.5 miles. Turn left onto S. Curtis Rd followed by a slight right onto W Gowen Rd for 0.6 miles. Take the 2nd right onto W Diamond St.

From the WEST: Take I-84 East.

From the NORTHWEST: Take I-15 South to I-84 East.

From the SOUTHEAST: Take I-84 West.
