Back in the old days, hand-printed dance posters (aka Flyers) were pinned to public bulletin boards to attract new dancers. They worked. Then came press-apply lettering, stencils, and felt-tip markers. The quality improved. Now, with the aid of computers we can design multi-color flyers to include graphics, multiple fonts, and photos. They look professional and attractive.

We continue to flyers to keep our current dancers informed, as well as to attract dancers from other areas. Now, with web-based email,

we can almost instantly deliver flashy posters to every dancer in the state. In addition, we now have downloadable flyers posted on our website, and the website has been averaging about 2500 hits per month.

It is important that we continue to apply the basics of journalism to each and every item of promotion we publish. To sum it up, every advertising bit, with no exceptions, must contain **WWWWW**.

Every flyer should include WHO is conducting the event, WHAT type of event is it, WHERE is the event to be held including complete address for us who depend on electronic guidance, WHY is this group scheduling the event, WHEN is the event happening giving complete date with year and time, and HOW is the event going to entertain us and make us happy we attended. Many dancers also want to know price, and whether RV parking/hookups is available.

We now have a wonderful system of informing our dancers, let's strive to always give complete and accurate information.
