### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

It is getting more difficult to find a good place to dance. Whether for your local club dances, or area festivals, ideal dance venues are not readily available.

In years past, local schools and fellowship halls would open their doors to community activities like square dancing and it was not hard to

locate a hardwood floor suitable for dancing. Modern buildings are almost entirely carpeted which is really bad for dancing.

Sound quality of the dance area is also important for our activity. Walls and floors which bounce the sound around make it very difficult for dancers to hear and understand the calls and cues. Softer ceilings and wall coverings really help to absorb sound and reduce the echoes.

If your group has a great hall, keep your relationship with the owners on amiable terms because, like new dancers, wonderful dance halls are also hard to find.
